

Vol 90 pp 7-17 (Nov Term 1840) Partition of estate of Oliver Langdon died. viz Tract deeded to him by Edward Noble (or ~~Robert~~) June 10 1813 (See Book I, p. 35) being the South east 1/4 Sec 21 3rd R. 2 E. except 26 2/100 ac taken out of N.E. cor in a regular square; and except a tract in the S.E. cor. of the 1/4 Sec. of 65 3/100 Ch. 67th by S. A. 2/100 Ch. N.S. deeded to Charles Langdon Also a tract deeded to said Oliver by Rachel Holden May 1. 1817 (Book 25 page 161) being part of ~~Sec 10 T. 2 R. 2 E.~~ about 100 acres, except however out of this tract the part deeded to James Langdon of about 5800. 9 1/2 pol. the N.W. by part. Also a tract deeded to said Oliver by donation of Samuel N. Hilditch Sept 10 1817 (Book 11. 76 2 p. 518) being the small Sec 14 T. 2 R. 2 E. estimated to contain 285 acres except the 2 E. by part of said tract of 95 2/100 acres deeded to Charles Langdon which has been set off to him by proceedings of court, also except 2 1/3 acres deeded by said Oliver to James D. Langdon (See Book 24 p. 36) Also a tract deeded to said Oliver by Daniel G. Carter 1819 (Book 11 p. 359) described as the North end of Sec 13 T. 2 R. 2 E. formerly in dispute, containing about 19 acres. Also a tract deeded by Henry Stiles to said Oliver July 26. 1808 (Book 11 page 605 or 1052) being 6 acres in N.E. cor of Sec 19 T. 2 R. 2 E. also a tract in Cincinnati, beginning on S. side of both Sts. between River below the at the N.E. cor of Jas D. Langdon's lot running S with the line of said lot 90 ft to a 10 ft alley thence E with said alley 22 1/2 ft to Race street; thence north with Race st 90 ft to both streets. thence west with both st 24 ft to place of beginning being lot No 81 on the plat of subdivision. Recorded Book V 76 2 page 412, deeded to said Oliver Langdon by Jas Ferguson (Book 22 p. 316) This lot in Cincinnati was by the Commission set off to Solomon Langdon; but their report says it being the lot No 80 10 ft off the E. side of lot No 81 on the Plat of subdivision. Record Book V 76 2 page 412 deeded to said Oliver Langdon beginning at the corner of Sec 13, 14, 19, 20 running W in line between Sec 14 & 20 — 1/2 mile to Duck Creek, thence up the creek with the meander thereof N 65° W 21 pol. N 10° E 28 pol. N 67° W 22 pol. to a black walnut tree, thence N 50° E 30 pol. N 35° E 26 pol. to cor of Jas Ferguson's tract on the bank of said creek, thence with a S.E. by line of said Ferguson lot N 40° 15' E 25 2/100 pol. to a post in the line between Sec 14 & 20 thence with said line 0° 7 1/2' W 120 poles to the beginning of tract in Sec 19 (also part of Down) E. d. more or less beginning at cor of Sec 13 14, 19, 20 running S 0° 7 1/2' W in line 66 2/100 pol. to Duck Creek thence up said creek with its meander to the cor of the above described tract in the line of Sec 14 & 20 thence with said line E to beginning
