


Vol 192 p. 125 - 132 (New Term 1849 - 1850) Emily Avery, or Francis Avery, for partition of Real Estate which they Transc. Avery, a minor by his Guardian George Hatch mutually agreed to divide the same as follows.
 (the Plat descriptive of that portion of the premises situated in Sec 19 T 3 pl. 2 m. being the plat of subdivision made by Avery & Kirby in 1835 with some addition slacks made by the said heirs themselves) We agree that the Share of Emily Avery shall be as follows to wit: all of Lot 4 in Hatch's Subdivision of Square 14 on Avery & Kirby's Plat, meas 25 ft. in front on N. side of Hamilton Road & extending back to the Miami Canal, all of Lot 7, in same square between same road & canal & of same extension all of 12 ft. fronting on N. side of Hamilton Road & running back to the canal, bound on the E. by Lot 11 in Hatch's subdivision of Square 14 as aforesaid on the N. side of ground of J. L. Bryant, all of lot 10 on N.E. cor. of Ham. Road & back the same 225 ft. in front on N. side of said road & extending back along E. line of Peattie St. to Miami Canal, bound on the E. by ground of W.M. Reynolds, all the lot, measure 281 ft. in front on N. side of Ham. Road and N. of Peattie St. & extending back along the N. line of Peattie St. to Miami Canal all the lot meas. 33 1/2 ft. in front on E. side of Peattie St. bounded on N. by Calvert St. on the S. by Lot 21 in Hatch Subdivision of Square 12 on Avery & Kirby's Plat & extending back from Peattie St. 100 ft. All of Lot 10 in Hatch's subdivision of Square 12 on Avery & Kirby's Plat, meas. 25 ft. front on N. side of Bank St. at the distance of 2.25 ft. E. of Peattie St. & extending back 100 ft. to Bank ally all the lot fronting on N. side of Bank ally, between the lots fronting on Peattie St. in Hatch Subdivision of Square 12 on Avery & Kirby's Plat, John Farren ground meas 24 ft. more or less on Bank ally & extending back Northwardly to Calvert St. all the lot between E. line of Peattie St. & Subdivision E. line of Freeman St. & extending from Bank St. to Ham. Road measuring 15 feet more or less, in width on Bank St. & 38 ft. m. o. l. on Ham. Road also all of 2,901 1/2 ft. more or less in front on N. side of Dayton Street next E. of Freeman Street & extending back along the E. line of Freeman St. 160 ft. being the whole of 1/4 of Square 14, consisting of 566 1/2 ft. more or less in front outside of Dayton St. extending from Freeman to Peattie St. back 150 ft. to York Alley being the whole of 1/4 of Square No. 2 on Avery & Kirby's Plat, all of 567 1/2 ft. more or less in front on N. side of York St. extending from Freeman St. to Peattie St. & extending back 150 ft. to York Alley, being the whole of 1/4 of Square No. 2 on Avery & Kirby's Plat, all of 3,981 ft. more or less in front on N. side of Dayton St. next E. of Peattie St. and extending back 150 ft. to Dayton Alley bounded on N. side of Peattie St. between Peattie and Graham Streets & extending back 150 ft. to York Alley being the whole of 1/4 of Square No. 5 on Avery & Kirby's Plat, all of 1,891 ft. in front on N. side of Dayton St. between Graham & Whiteman Streets & extending back to Dayton Alley being the whole of 1/4 of Square 9 on Avery & Kirby's Plat, all of 417 ft. in front on N. side of Bank St. extending from Whiteman street to Boston Row & extending back from Bank St. 150 ft. to Dayton Alley, being all of 1/4 of the Whiteman Lot so called, all of the lot triangular in shape, lying between Boston Row & the Miami Canal, being the E. end of the Whiteman Lot, measuring 150 ft. m. o. l. on the E. & N. lines & about 60 ft. on the S. line, bounding S. ground of Proctor & Gamble all the 415 1/2 ft. in front on S. side of Cuders Alley at the distance of 150 ft. E. of Nine Street & extending back 20 ft. in depth to grounds of E. H. Druffell & T. B. Mason, all of 113 1/2 ft. in front on S. side of the Canal market place, at the distance of 150 ft. E. of Nine Street & extending back 74 ft. in depth to Cuders Alley and that the share of Francis Avery Shall be, all of lot 1 in Hatch's Subdivision of Square 14 on Avery & Kirby's Plat, measuring 25 ft. front on N. side of Hamilton Road & extending back to the Miami Canal, all of lot 10 in same Subdivision N. side of Hamilton Road & of same dimensions as aforesaid Lot 10, all of ground fronting on Ham. Road in Square No. 12 on Avery & Kirby's Plat, meas 142 1/2 ft. in front on S. side of Ham. Road next E. of Peattie St. & extending back 140 ft. m. o. l. to Calvert Street.

all of Lot 14 in Hatch's Subdivision of Square 12 in Avery & Kirby's Plat being 25 ft. in front on N. side of Bank St. and extending back 100 ft. to Bank Alley being at the distance of 225 ft. E. of Main St., all of 28 1/2 ft. m. o. l. in front on S. side of Bank road E. of Freeman St. & extending back along the line of Freeman St. 160 ft. being the W. part of the N. 1/2 of Square 3. in Avery & Kirby's Plat, all of 27 1/2 ft. m. o. l. in front on S. side of York St. next E. of Freeman St. & extending back along the line of Freeman St. 167 1/2 ft. being the E. part of the N. 1/2 of Square 1. in Avery & Kirby's Plat, all of 28 1/2 ft. in front on N. side of Maple Street next E. of Freeman St. & extending back along the E. line of Freeman St. 167 1/2 ft. being the E. part of 1/2 of Square 1. in Avery & Kirby's Plat, all of 28 1/2 ft. in front on N. side of Bank St. next E. of York Street & extending back along the whole of the N. 1/2 of Square 4. in Avery & Kirby's Plat, all of 58 3 ft. m. o. l. in front on N. side of York Street & extending from East to Graham Street running back 150 feet to Dayton Alley, being the whole 1/2 of Square 5 or in Avery & Kirby's Plat. All of 18 1/2 ft. in front on S. side of Bank Street between Graham & Whitteman Streets & extending back 150 ft. to Dayton Alley being the whole of the N. 1/2 of Square 7. in Avery & Kirby's Plat, all of 56 5 ft. m. o. l. in front on N. side of Dayton Street between Whitteman Street & Weston Row & extending back to Dayton Alley being the S. 1/2 of the Whitteman lot so called. all of 65 feet in front on N. side of Main Street next N. of 1st Street & extending back along the N. line of 1st Street 100 ft. being Lots 163 164 & part of 165 on Benham Plat. all of 50 ft. in front on N. side of 1st Street & extending back along the E. line of Clay Street 75 ft. being part of Lots 149, 150 & 151 over Benham Plat all of 25 ft. in front on N. side of Eighth Street, between Race & Elm & extending back 90 m. o. l. to an alley being the 25 ft. of Lot No. 27 in Square 4 of Clark & Grounding Plat. all of 35 ft. in front on S. side of Third Street at the distance of 79 ft. E. of Elm Street & extending back 90 ft. in depth, part of Lot No. 181, all of 150 ft. in front on N. side of First Street & extending back along the line of Weston Row 85 ft. m. o. l. to Graham Alley and \$26.33 in cash to be paid by Lincoln Avery.
