Confirmed by Court March 2 1836, ordered that a County Road be opened 100 feet wide pursuant to this survey commencing on the bank of the Ohio opposite the residence of widow Selzer, in Miami Township and terminating at the mouth of Rapid Run in Dallas Township and that no road of the old road be in between those points he recalled & not aside.
