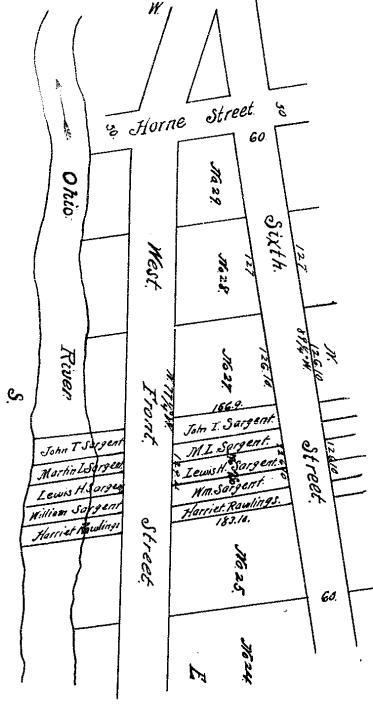

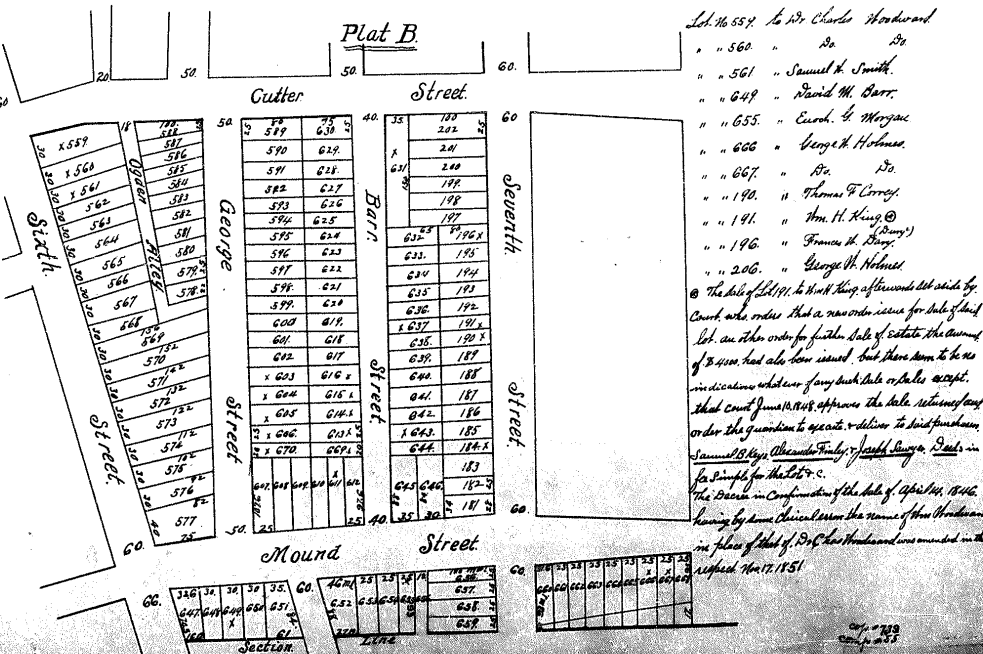
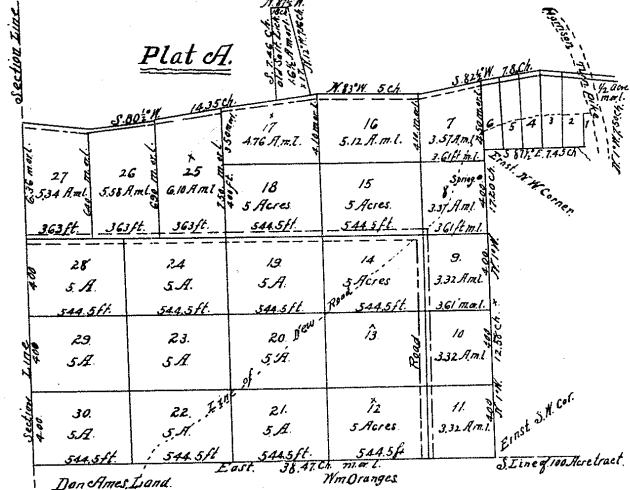

 @ The list of Lot 191, in which thing afterwards set aside by Court, was ordered that a new order issue for the sale of said lot. see other order for further sale of estate the sum of \$84000 had also been raised. but there seem to be no indication whatever of any such sale or sales except that Court June 10, 1848, approved the sale returned and ordered the guardian to execute & deliver to said purchaser, Samuel B. King, Ebenezer Frick, Joseph Sargent, Deeds in full discharge of the debt &c. The Deeds in Confirmation of the sale of April 10, 1848, having by some clerical error the name of Wm. Howard instead of that of Dr. Charles Howard was omitted on that respect Nov 17, 1851
