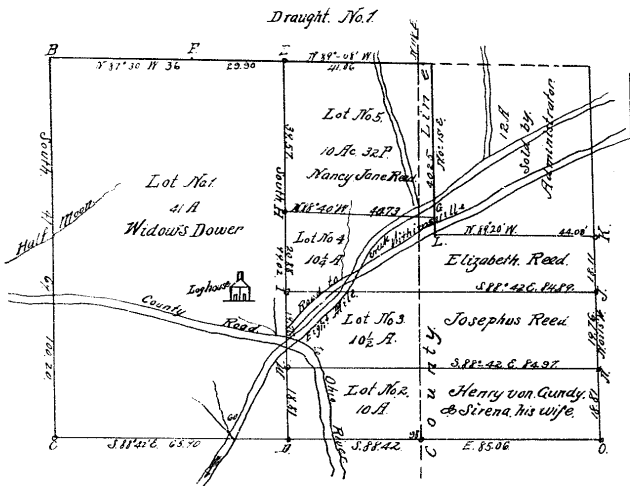
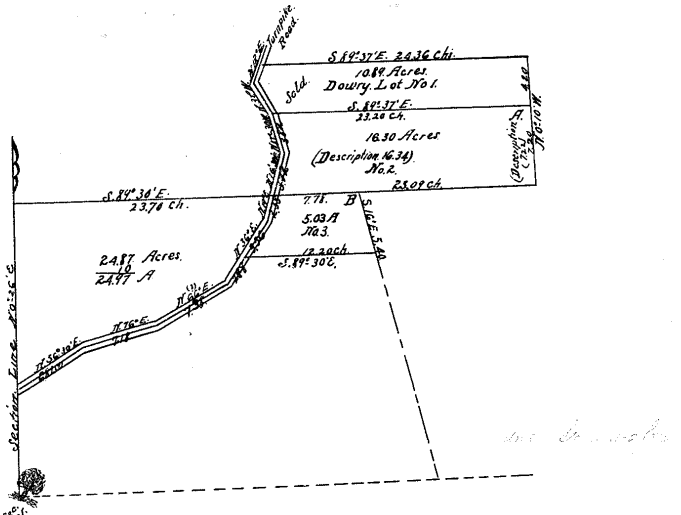


Vol. 142 p. 778 (May Term 1847, 1162) Particulars of estate of Robert Reed, to-wit: all the tract on the western side of Eight Mile Creek, being part of a tract one in Survey No. 11 purchased of James Taylor & Ann Lytle as first Deeds dated April 11, 1803, the other a part of 1/20 then purchased of the said James Taylor & Ann Lytle, Deed June 15, 1817 beginning at a stone on the E. line of the first mentioned tract of the said James Taylor & Ann Lytle, with his line 100 poles bearing thence N. 81° 30' E. 50 poles to a stone in the aforesaid line thence S. 15° 10' E. 150 poles to the first mentioned line being also the line of John Humber, thence N. 75° 00' E. 50 poles to the beginning containing 100 poles more or less. The tract also on Eight Mile Creek, conveyed by the above Deed of James Taylor dated June 15, 1817 as beginning at three sugar trees being the S. W. Corner of the first purchase of said Taylor & Ann Lytle, thence N. 81° 30' E. 88 poles to a stone in James Helderline's line thence S. 13° 14' 57" E. 80 poles to a diagonal line to Catherine McHenry's line thence S. 87° 16' E. 88 poles with said Catherine's line to a stone thence N. 23° E. 57 poles to the beginning containing 30 poles more or less. Also another tract on the western side of Eight Mile Creek, beginning at a crossroad Centre Daniel Dunder's in his line thence S. 87° 16' E. to a bush, on to Daniel Dunder's original purchase 76 poles thence E. 117 poles to a stake in Daniel Dunder's line on to John Nantz's thence with his line 50 poles to a stone thence N. 15° 00' E. to a stone in Helderline's line thence N. 75° 00' E. 50 poles to the beginning containing 100 poles more or less.

Surveyed for the administrators of David B. Bassett died in Dec. 13, 1822, Nov. 27, 1847, 1840. The figures for areas & distances in the Town of Raleigh are 206 acres, including within the record year when entered they are with the Deeds of 1823, 3.2. at Highway 5 in S. 23.4. 2.4. the White Walnut 10 in 73.4. 20.4. 18.4. the one old stake on the E. line of the 2^d tract called 2^d the N. W. Cor. to Columbus Williams land. 2^d old stake 20 in S. 20.5. 17.4. the 2^d a 1/2 acre in 91.30. 14.39. 1/4. the Daniel Harker's Public Sale. S. 24. 22. 11. 10. on the Plat of lands made by the W.
