Land below Mill Creek on the N.W. side of Sec. 30 T. 4 R. 1. 1/2 (the Miami being a part of the tract set off to said Price as one of the heirs of Comm. Price by the Court the partition described being that part of Lot No. 3 of Sec. 30 T. 4 R. 1. 1/2 (see Plat in Book 274 page 2 of Deeds) which belongs to the said Price (M) estate & the part of Lot No. 3 (see Plat in Book 274 page 2 of Deeds) which belongs to the estate and is not included in the above from the administration of John H.
