Field Notes Beginning at the supposed N. E. Cor of a certain 100 acre tract formerly owned by Jas. Stewart, dec'd (see certain corner are to be found without first surveying the lands by which the estate is bounded) thence S. 34 1/2 W. 100 feet, thence S. 75° E. 117 feet, thence S. 16° E. 160 feet, thence N. 81° 30' E. 15.7 feet, thence S. 63.84 feet, thence N. 81° 30' E. 81.6 feet, thence N. 116.84 feet, to the Sec. line thence N. 81° 30' E. 25 feet, thence N. 0° 30' W. 150 feet, thence S. 53° 15' W. 109 feet, thence S. 0° 45' E. 105 feet, thence S. 81° 30' W. 21.38 feet, to the place of beginning.
