





Viz. all of lot No. 27 in the Subdivs. of lots made by the heirs of Jesus Gardner, in the 1st cor. part of Cincinnati measuring about 103 1/2 ft. from N. to S. about 127 ft. from E. to W. bounded on the S. by the Ohio River, extended to include that part of the lot on N. side of Grand St. now Mill Creek Bridge and a few rods of the house where the said Josiah Gardner formerly resided, measuring 75 ft. in front of Grand St. & extending back N. westerly at right angles with Grand St. 100 ft. more or less, length of N. 20 ft. the same being 12 ft. long word & D. In describing the width of front of the lots of Grand St. it is intended that the measurement shall run at right angles across the said lots so that the said lots shall be of the same width of the corresponding lots of Grand St.
