



Vol. 73 p. 40-47 (Feb., 1838) Partition among of Power in estate as follows: 2 Tracts in Soc. T. 73 lat. N. 2 deg. 20' as conveyed by John Redhead to Mary Peague (the petitioners) & Leopoldo Langley (See Dist. Ch. 2, p. 571) 1st. Beginning at a point on S. bound of said tract 11ch 28l from E. on thereof thence with the same N. 34° W. 32 1/2 pd. to E. end thereof & back thence N. 34° W. 58 pd. to state line via Badgley from which N. 34° E. 5 1/2 chchesomes 16 1/2' E. 77 1/2 pd. to E. white ash stump on road 6th S. E. corner said Badgley, thence S. 45° E. 5 1/2' 177 1/2 pd. to a stone, thence N. 17° E. 5 1/2' 18 1/2 pd. to beginning. Contain. 21 1/2 acres which was set off to Jas.
