





Allen of the land of Bartlett Vincent dec'd, thence running E. on Stone of said Vincent till it strikes the County Rd. running E. & W. thence S. along said Rd. to W. line of John Ross, thence S. along said Town's W. & E. of lands of Jacob Allen dec'd thence N. along said W. line to County Rd. running N. & S. thence N. on said Rd. to place of beginning town, about 75 acres being a 1/2 main div of the 220 acres in Sec. 12 conveyed to said Nathaniel Allen by said Thomas, Jacob Dumas & Wm. 
