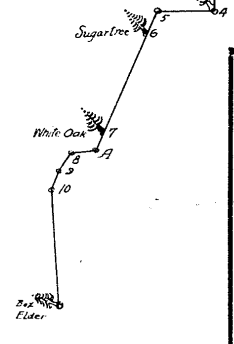


Vol 80 p 86-94 (June Term 1837) Aaron Brown administrator of James Flinn vs James Flinn appeal. Following suit first had administration removed. Commencing on the road from Mt Pleasant to the Union Road, at the intersection below James Flinn's land, thence along said line through the lands of Jacob McIlhenny to Bond's West line, thence along said line as far as Jacob's line thence to Mc Tully's Mill, thence down the creek to intersect a road from Albion to Burlington Meeting house. 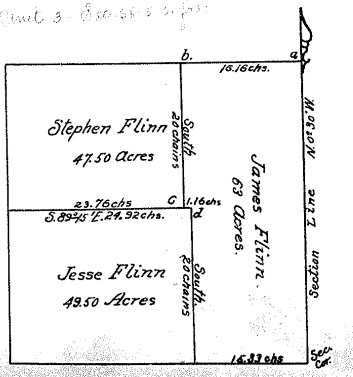
- Beginning at a Gum tree on the North side of the said road from Mt Pleasant to the Union Road in the line between David S. Hill and James Webster

- through Square hole land thence N 70° 10' E 25.77 chs to a Logwood tree thence N 89° 30' E 9.00 chs to a stake at 5
- thence N 28° 45' E 5.70 chs to a sugar tree 5 inches
- thence N 74° E 22 chs to a White Oak tree 36 inches diameter
- near Mc Tully's Mill, thence N 74° E 2.85 chs to a
- thence S 75° E 4.41 chs to x

- thence N 11° 51' W 4.78 chs to 10
- thence N 13 1/2° W 22.70 chs to Drop Elder at 11, which is the terminus of said Road. Making 2 miles 7 chains and 2 links. Surveyed December 23, 1836

3 Damages to be paid out of the Mc Tully's estate. Therefore a new appeal entered on the immediately following paper, when the survey with the Road is recorded but where the plan above marked a mistake of 11° 10' E at stake 11, 7° 15' E. Damages must be paid out of said Mc Tully's estate and then an order will issue from Court to open the Road as heretofore ordered.

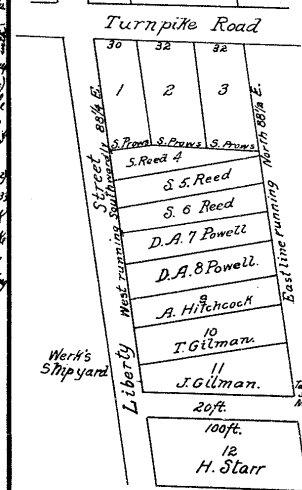
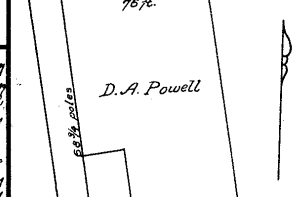

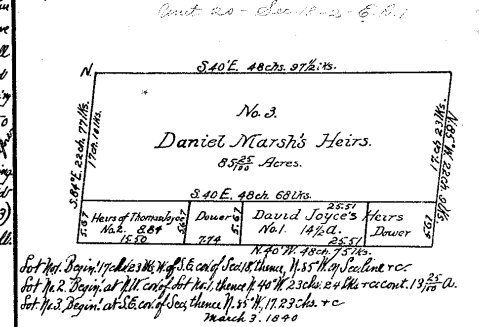
