


The Bounds of the Survey, made Beginning of April 1845, are as follows: Beginning at the Point in Stephen's Section Line, at which a north line of Road leading to McDonald's Settlement, or town in Stephen's Range, about 6.75 miles to a stake corner to S. E. corner of the section line, then N. 87° E. to a stake corner to S. E. corner of the section line, then S. 162° E. to a stake corner to S. E. corner of the section line, then N. 98° E. to a point on the line of McDonald's Settlement, or town in Stephen's Range, said Road 16.25 pds. to begining 9.94, 36 poles for 1/3 by description as 28 1/2 rods wide & cont 23.37 A.
