


T. 1848 - No. 604) Eliza A. Bickham, Guardian, Petitioning Writ, of part of Estate of William Bickham, dec'd. viz. R. 1, M. P. on the N. & W.
 Bank of the Ohio River, W. of Bolt Face Run: Beginning in the middle of the River Road, lead from Cn. 8 to North Bend at thence along the middle of said road, the following course and distance viz: S. 24° 4' W. 20 1/2 ft. to thence 28 1/2° N. 110.4 ft. from S. 1° 10' E. 18 1/2 ft. to an inclined plane S. 31 1/2° E. 80 ft. to leavelate in the Ohio River, thence up the river along the line of low water mark, with the meanders of said river about 20 poles. River shown with Sydman's Line N. 46 1/2 W. 50 ft. of m. a. ft. place of Beginning certain about 14 acres including the ground occupied by the Whitewater Canal about 2 1/2 acres also described tract No. 7 of the Whitewater Canal and can therefore be retained & preserved from deterioration abnormally caused, which part therefor the petitioner does not propose to sell.
