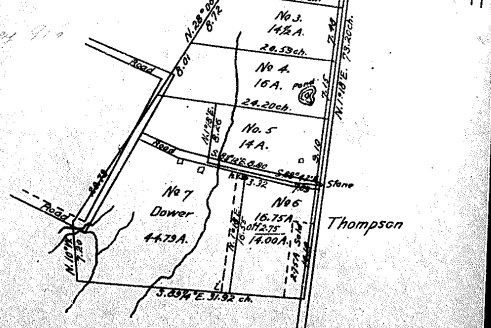
- A. N. 1/2 cor. of Section
