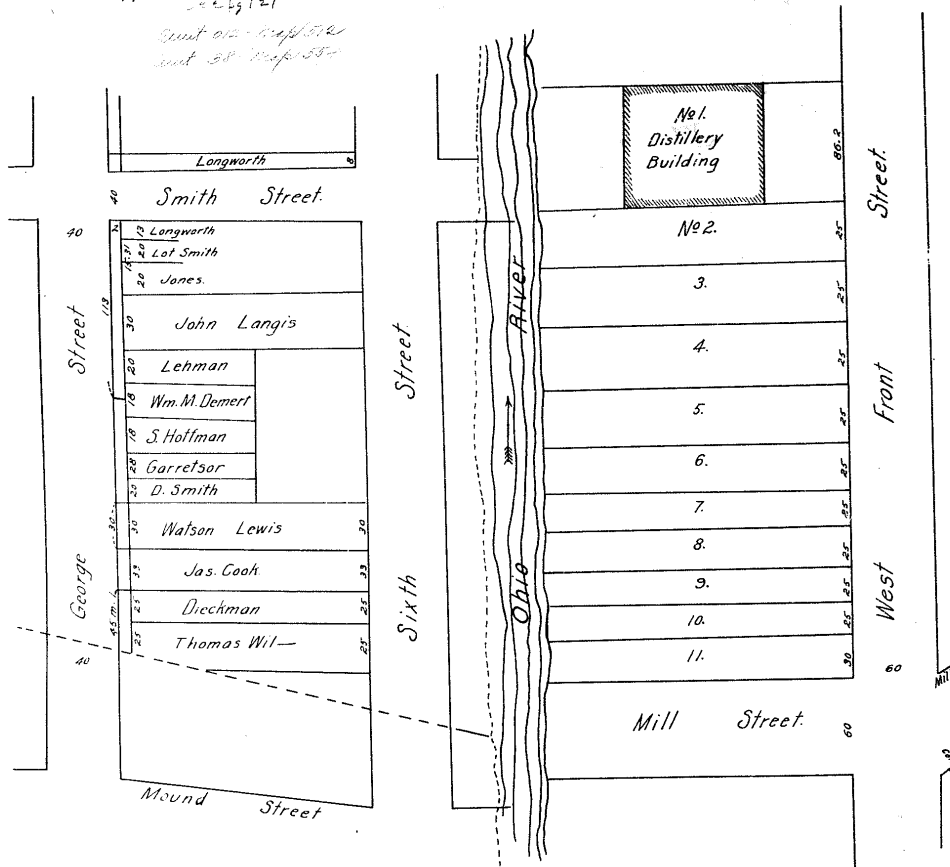
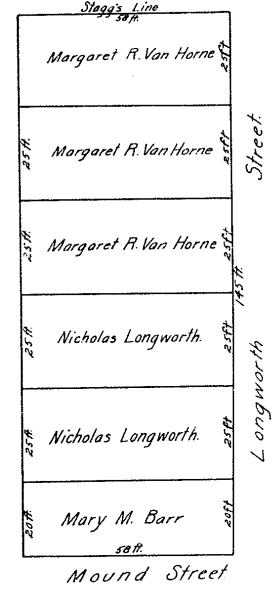


Vol. 157 p. 526-600 Continued. Continuation of Plat of Richard F. F. Hommedieu's Estate on Side of George Street



Vol. 151 - p. 311-320 (May 9, 1845) Partition of Estate of Wm. Barr
 dec'd. vs. Beginning cor. of Mound & Longworth streets, thence running South by
 Longworth st. to Staggs Line 145 ft. (or thereabouts) thence Northwardly with said Staggs line 50 ft. to
 line of Dick Longworth, thence Northwardly with said Longworth line on a line & Longworth st. to
 mound st. thence with mound st. Southly to place of Beginning.



The tract described under No. 4 & known as Phayors Steam Mill & Distillery
 Commission have a plan of in parcels (as per plat) following attached to
 their return these being as appears from actual survey 237 1/2 ft. front street
 measure between the W. line of Mill St. & Hopkins line. Lot No. 1 (the lot on which
 the Distillery building stands) beginning on S. line of East Front st. 100 ft. line of
 Second Hopkins land running thence Southly, along S. line of Front st. 82 ft. on which
 being the width of the distillery building, thence Southly at a r. with Front st.
 S.W. 40 ft. to a low water mark on the Ohio River. The other ten lots or
 parcels are described in same manner as Lot No. 1 (yet, for want of their
 respective front on Front st. See Plat here following) & are parts of Yeatman &

 To Wm. S. W. Davis, Lots 6 & 7 (44 & 45 respectively)
