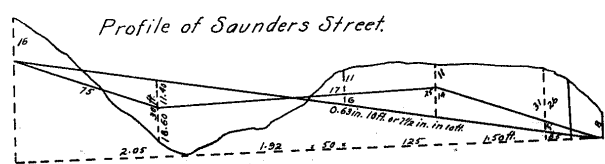
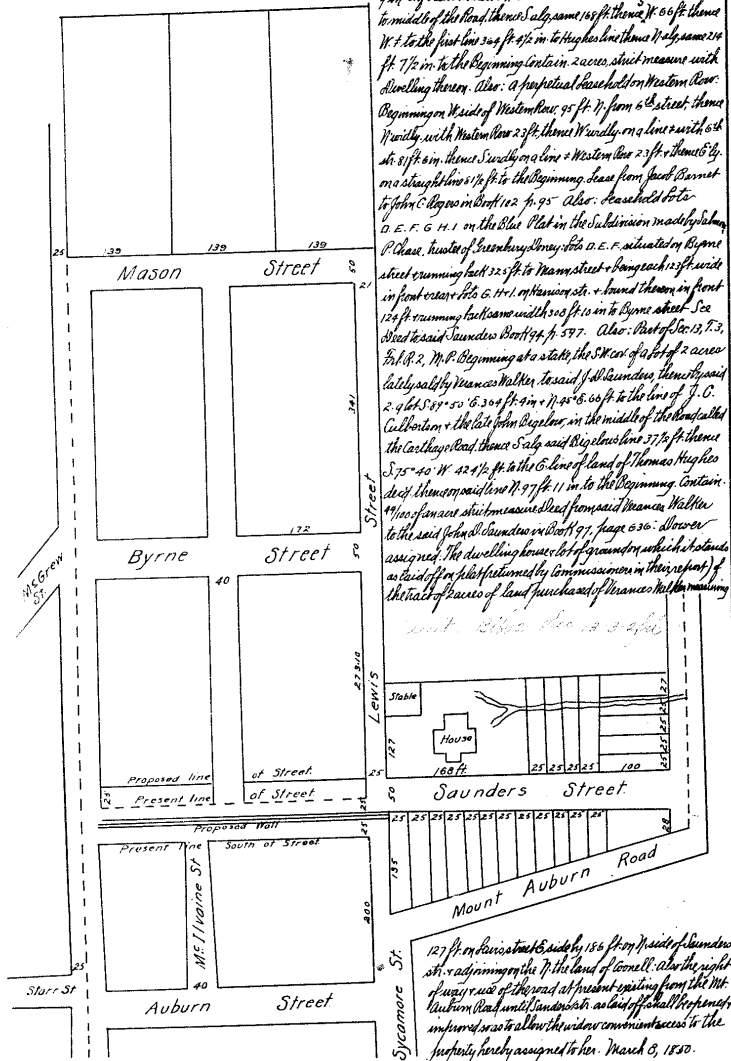


Vol. 153, pp. 108-116 (Jan'y Term 1850 - No. 2024) Mary, widow of the late John A. Saunders on Chancery for
 2 acres, part of tract conveyed to her in 1816, by Jacob & Mary, part of lot 13 (near Linnetts) formerly
 called James Loyal farm - the N. 1/2 of 50 A. conveyed by A. Harvey to said Mary & her son on 15/16 said 2 acres Beginning 217 ft
 9 in S. of Lewis Barlow S. W. cor. thence S. 71° 10' E. to said Barlow line 41 ft
 to middle of the road, thence S. 71° 10' E. same 105 ft thence N. 65° 45' E. thence
 W. 7 to the first line 300 ft 4 1/2 in to High line thence W. by same 230
 ft 7 1/2 in to the Beginning certain 2 acres shut measure with
 dwelling there. Also: a perpetual easement on Western Row
 Beginning on West of Western Row 95 ft N. from S. of street thence
 N. westerly with Western Row 23 ft thence W. westerly on a line 2 with 6 ft
 to 8 1/2 ft 6 in thence S. westerly on a line 2 23 ft thence S. 71°

Vol. 153, pp. 413-421 (May T. 1850 - No. 4599) Partition of division of estate of Andrew Mc. Millan dec'd viz:
 Sec. 14, T. 3, R. 2, M. P. Beginning at a point in the center of the intersection of the Carriage + Auburn Road (1) of Mt. Auburn
 + 150 ft of the S. line of said lot at the S. line of thence N. 31° 1/4' W. 5 1/2' to the center of the Carriage Road thence on line + S.
 line of said lot 13 1/2' ch. to W. line of Burnet S. 74° 1/2' W. 2 1/2' ch. to the center of the said Carriage Road thence N. 57 1/2'
 W. 5 1/2' ch. with the center of said Carriage Road, thence S. 90° W. 5 1/2' to the center of said Carriage Road, to the place of Beginning.
 Containing 4 acres. Commissioners subdivision of the premises.
 Set off to Alexander Mc. Millan lots 7, 8, 14, 16, 21, 22, 26, 27, 28 ft of 29, to be taken off the E. side next to lot 28.
 " " Maria L. Mc. Millan lots 1, 2, 9, 10, 19, 20, 25, 33, 34.
 " " Margaret Mc. Millan lots 3, 4, 11, 12, 17, 18, 27, 35, 36, 32
 " " John A. Mc. Millan lots 5, 6, 13, 15, 23, 31, 29, 31, 30, 5 feet off lot 29, next to lot 30.

The whole + acres are included in the tract A. B. C. D. E. The
 distance as given in feet was hundred and fifteen. The 15 ft. of the line D. E. is
 laid out with the interpretation of the Comrs. adding 15 ft. to make a 30 ft.
 street, we therefore remove 2 ft. on the said line D. E. (approximating at
 this time 13 ft.) until the Comrs. dedicate at least 12 ft. in addition to the
 15 ft. of the Mc. Millan property and a longer street than the whole to be
 opened as above represented July 1850. John P. Verboom, Surveyor.
