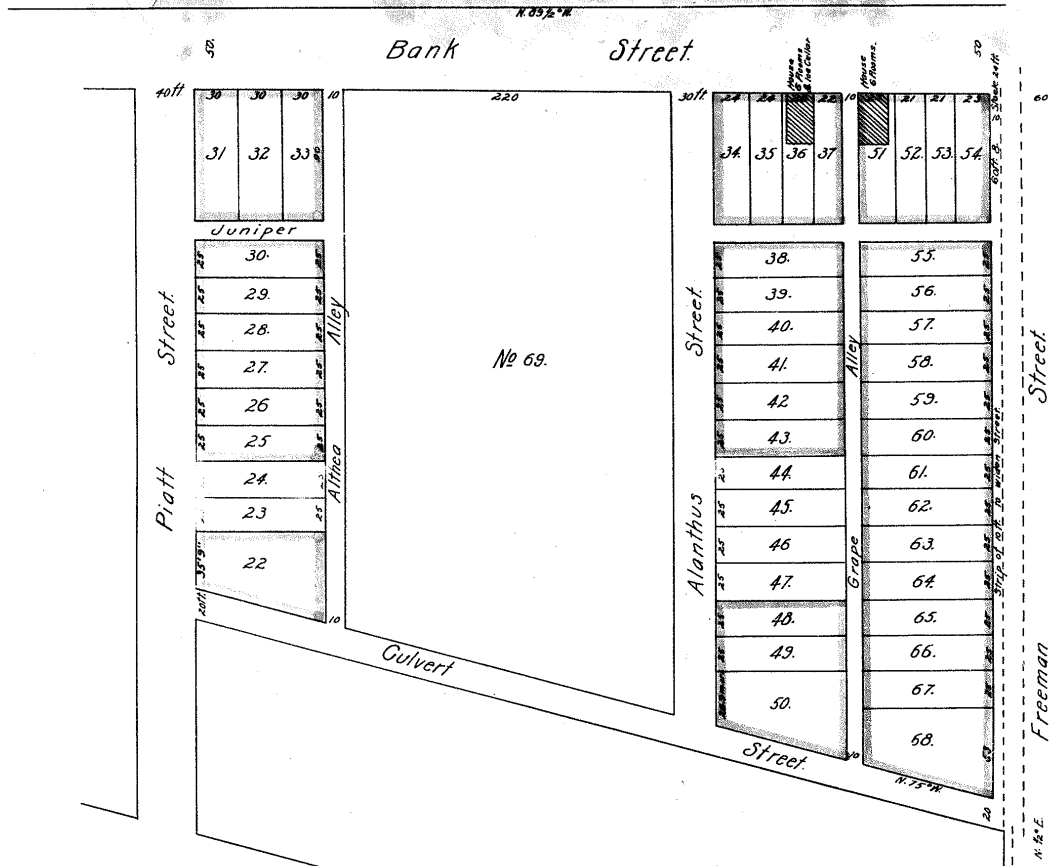


Vol. 169, p. 275-364. (July Term 1850-1853) *Wm. Cutteworth vs. Daniel Sans et al.* Complamant having recovered judgment against Defendant in August 1840. Execution on real estate of said Sans which estate is described but of which no plot is presented except the one here submitted and which reflects full and correct information upon the names of Defendants (filled with the names of Mrs. Sans) Plot of lands of said Sans subdivided in Northern Liberties of the city of Cincinnati made by Daniel Sans in or about Oct. 5, 1846. Each 50 ft. in width. Bounded N. by Bank Street, S. by Hamilton Road, E. by Freeman Street, W. by Piatt Street. The plot is divided by an Alley into two parts. The lot numbers are as follows: 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68.



The tract thus subdivided by D. Sans is described as follows (in the Bill)

The tract being part of the middle 1/2 of the E. 1/2 of Sec. 19, T. 3, R. 2, M. P. Beginning at a point on the N. E. cor. of Bank St. from which point the S. W. cor. of Daniel Sans's stone house is 17.0 ft. N. 70° 34' W. the N. E. cor. of M. W. chimney of J. J. Lamb's Brick house is 50.0 ft. S. 50° 14' E. the S. E. cor. of Bank St. being 50 ft. in width running due East + West across the Graham + Rice place so called at 16 ft. distance from the N. E. cor. of the main building known as the Graham County Seat from the said point being the N. W. cor. of Bank + Piatt streets running N. + S. on the N. side of Bank St. 53 ft. from the point of beginning running due North at right angles from Bank St. the width of 55 ft. on the Hamilton Road, forming a tract or parcel of land 550 ft. front on Hamilton Road to Bank St. from N. to S. including 6 ft. of Piatt St. 41 ft. width of which street + half street across the N. side of the Whitman lot so called, have been reserved for public highways, including the large mansion house occupied by said D. Sans, with the appurtenances, except 2 1/2 lots fronting on Hamilton Road taking the whole front of said tract extend back about 144 ft. 9 in. to a 20 ft. alley, which lots have long ago been sold under a decree of this court in the case of Harvey Richards vs. D. Sans et al. in a former term of Complamants except lots being 25 ft. front on Hamilton Road + extend back 114 ft. 9 in. to a 20 ft. alley. Sheriff's Sale June 15<sup>th</sup> 1847 (lots 23, 24, 30, 44, 45, 46, 47; have already long ago since the division was made on the Bench (1847).
