



1847, 1854, 1857, 1858, 1859 ( June Term 1857 - J. 1858 ) John Alce Joseph Ray & Wendolph B. Smith vs. Ricky, Dec. James Mason. Ejectment from the foll. lands: a lot 150 ft. in front on the W. side of a street running nearly N. & S. with a Spring street extending W. at right angles with the said street on which it lies 90 ft. m. c. to a 12 ft. alley bounded on the north by property belong to the estate of Horton Howard & south by property of Charles Fox & John Sullivan to be held for 50 years from March 20, 1850 & demised from Chas. Fox to John Alce. Also, a lot (demised by the Ohio Life Insurance & Trust Co. March 20, 1850 to the said John) in Cincinnati measuring 150 ft. in front on the side of a street now called Pendleton street, running nearly North & South, & a Spring street extending W. at right angles with Pendleton str. 90 ft. m. c. to a 12 ft. alley bound on the N. by property then or recently belong to Horton Howard & south by the land of Charles Fox. To have held for 50 years - also a lot in Cincinnati - demised March 20, 1857 by Wendolph B. Smith to said John - situated on W. side of Pendleton street between Woodward str. & the Corporation line & bounded as follows: Beginning on W. side of Pendleton str. at the S.E. cor. of a lot formerly sold by Chas. Fox to Horton Howard & running thence South, along the W. line of Pendleton str. 150 ft. thence W. wadly str. a. with Pendleton str. 90 ft. m. c. to an alley, thence N. wadly & Pendleton str. along the S. line of the alley 150 ft. to the S.W. cor. of the lot sold to Horton Howard as afd. thence South wadly, said Howard's S. line 90 ft. m. c. to Pendleton str. at the point of beginning above the str. on March 20, 1850 demised by Joseph A. Ray to the said John - on W. side of Pendleton str. 150 ft. S. cor. of lot, formerly sold by Chas. Fox to Horton Howard & running thence N. along the W. line of Pendleton str. 20 ft. thence W. wadly str. a. with Pendleton str. 90 ft. m. c. to an alley thence South wadly, along the S. line of said alley & Pendleton str. 20 ft. thence South wadly str. a. with Pendleton str. at the point of beginning to have held for 50 years from date.

Survey made by me for Messrs. McInnes & Holman of property on Pendleton street, to ascertain the true line of a lot lying south of & between the Fox & Sullivan & Horton Howard, the South line of said lot being described as 150 ft. South of said Howard premises as represented in the Plat. The South line of said corner is 6 1/2 inches South of the North side of said lot, now now occupied & sold to James Mason which South line is 20 1/2 ft. 6 1/2 inches North of Woodward street. A. W. Sheriff's Sale Oct. 14, 1841. Lot No. 7. (on Pendleton Street.)  
 acquiesced to a subdivision of said real estate, made by John C. Amey, the Sheriff in this case, said lot No. 7 measuring in front 17 ft. 7 inches, on Pendleton street running East & West, with 102 ft. town alley. Sheriff's deed. dated Dec. 1, 1841. to James Mason.
