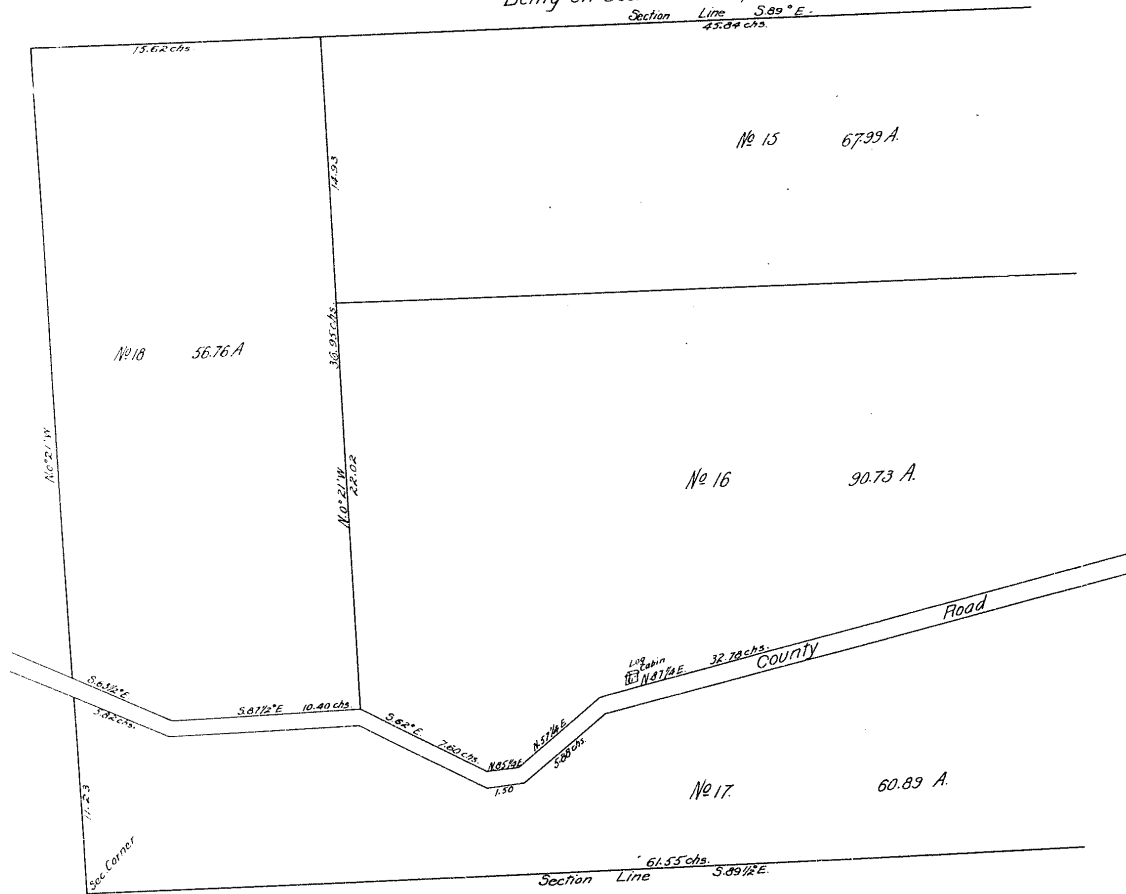


Dec. 171 ff. p. 14-53 (May Term 1851 - 1852) Andrew Forrie vs. Matthias Kugler et al. Foreclosure of mortgage given on the following premises to wit: The South sides of the 13<sup>th</sup> + 19<sup>th</sup> Tract Sections T.R. 6.R.1, M.P. The said tract Sections 13 + 19 being first divided by a line drawn from the Little Miami, due West across the said numbers 17 + 19 so as to make an equal division in quantity leaving one equal half part in quantity, South of said division line which is hereby conveyed to Andrew Forrie. Being the land conveyed by John Symmes to Christian Waldsmith by Deed dat Dec. 8. 1797. (Book C. ff. p. 74-75 + 76 and afterwards conveyed by Wm. Buffin Sheriff to said Matthias Kugler and wife, under an order of the Supreme Court in a case of Partition betw. the heirs of said Christian Waldsmith, by Deed of July. 19. 1817. (Book R. 70.1 ff. p. 146-157.) Said mortgage recorded in Book 124, p. 340.

Being on Sections 13 & 19, Town 5, E. R. 1, M. P. Filed March 28, Recorded in Book 1 of Plats. Pages 86 & 87.
