


Vol 201, p. 166-172 (November Term 1851-1852) John Melandy vs Heirs of James Melandy & David Gallup for Partition of 36 1/2 acres 27 rods N. E. corner of 11 1/4 Section 7, 3d P.R. 2, N.Y.P. Beginning at S.E. cor. of Andrew Cox's land & running thence W. 73 rods for the width & extending so far to the middle line of the section being 9 rods in length from N. E. to S. E. a metes & bounds description set forth from the Executor of Wm. Woodward of the partition of said lands between the heirs of H. Tyler, said deed being to the said heirs and reference is also made to the Deed of the said Woodward for the tract of land hereby conveyed. Commissioners Report. Survey of widow of James Melandy an annuity.



Vol 201, p. 165-166 (May Term 1851-1852) Partition between the Heirs of Henry Avery of land in lot 12 in Section 11, 3d P.R. according to the action and judgment returned thereon June 25, 1851. Emily & Francis Avery, each herself & her husband each having full right and power to make partition of a part of her/his land & render unto the other as to the remaining half tract the share had under 1/2 description of which will more fully appear in the title to the boundary lines to which reference is here made. These heirs in this agreed partition have at public war the rights as master in the plot except Hatch & Hatch streets which have been held for estate of attorney. Hatch street extending southward from east street North about 140 ft to the corner of Avery's land the line of the street being 8 rods wide. It is that part of Hatch street which runs back on the summit of the hill. Russell street extending southward from Hatch street about 137 ft to the corner of Avery's land being 8 rods wide. Both these streets extending southward from Hatch street which runs North to the summit. Moral Street extending southward from Hatch street back to the corner line being 8 rods wide & back of Russell street. Avery's property: all of lot 12 and 1/2 of lands formerly of Jacob Laymiller, n. S. of lands of Nicolas Augustus on the N. by his heirs so called & wife Lydia. Also west of Black H. all of Black H. & F. Clark & F. Clark & his grand family of H. Tyler. By heirs of J.
