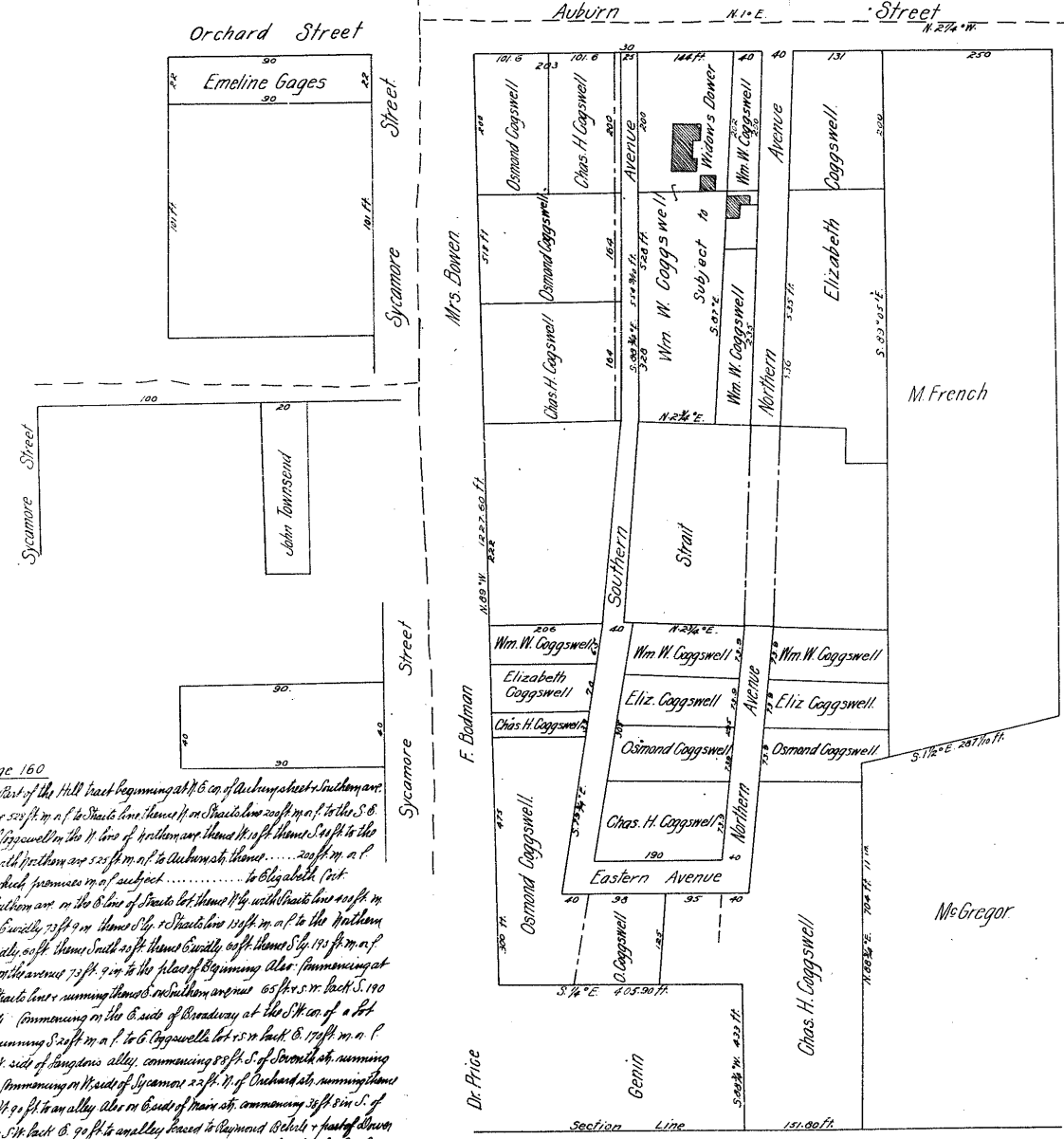

To William W. Coggswell. East of the Hill tract beginning at N. E. cor. of Auburn street & Southern ave. running thence due east 400 ft. N. E. cor. of State line thence N. on State line 200 ft. N. E. to the S. E. cor. of a lot assigned to Elizabeth Coggswell on the W. line of Northern ave. thence W. 10 ft. thence S. 10 ft. to the S. E. cor. of Northern ave. thence W. with Northern ave. 525 ft. N. E. to Auburn st. thence 200 ft. N. E. to place of beginning, about 1/2 of which premises are of subject to Elizabeth (not also commencing on the S. side of Northern ave. on the E. line of State lot thence N. E. with State line 40 ft.
