


Uof. 132 p. 42-56 (May Term 1816 - No. 328) Partition of Estate of Elathan Kemper viz: In mill tract
 It's bound on S. by Section line dividing Sections 7 & 8 N. by the 1/2 Section line N. of the land of Peter French owned by James Hart & by the
 Montgomery Road & West Boundary lands, of being all of 16 1/4 Sec. 8 & 1/3 Sec. 9 & 1/3 N. Playing N. of the center of the Montgomery Road
 (describing a lot of land conveyed to Peter H. Kemper et al as trustees of churchly debts bond as full beginning at front N.
 72 ft from Montgomery Road distance 2 1/2 lbs. and directly N. of the S. line 62 ft to the house W. 3/4 ch. thence W. 1/4 ch.
 thence E 1/2 ch. N. 1/2 ft to front distant from the Montgomery Road N. 72 ft 62 1/2 ft to the house S. 1/4 ch. N. parallel to said road 197 1/2
 ft. to point of beginning (about 1000 acres). Also except a lot conveyed to James Dowmyer (Deed Recd. 5/2 p. 657) commencing
 at N. cor. of the church lot (lot being 1/2 ch. of S. line) & going 3 1/2 ch. thence E. & thence 2 1/4 ch. thence S. & thence
